Successful applicants are typically department heads/chairs and senior academics (full, associate and assistant professors), directors and senior executives with relevant experience. Fellows in the Academy are recognized for demonstration of significant efforts to advance the translational medicine and mission of ATMP. Successful professionals may receive Fellowship certificates at annual congress of the European society for translational medicine (EUSTM)

Application Procedure

Eligibility

Clinicians and graduates holding degrees with at least five years of experience in disciplines encompassing benchside, bedside or community healthcare fields. Eligible disciplines include cellular & molecular biology, genetics, microbiology & immunology, pharmacy, veterinary sciences, drug discovery & development, biophysics & engineering, stem cells & regenerative medicine, public health & epidemiology, data mining & management, biomarkers and clinicians. Category One

Applicants in this category will receive certification based on evaluation of their track records and experience without qualifying examination.

Category One

Applicants under this category must successfully complete the qualifying examination in order to become eligible for fellowship. Qualifying examination is held once a year at occasion of Annual Congress of the European society for Translational Medicine.

FAcadTM Qualifying Examination

Category two applicants must pass the qualifying exam in order to become eligible for fellow. The next qualifying exam (MCQs type) will be held on 19th October, 2017 (Half an hour duration) at occasion of EUSTM-2017 Congress in Berlin, Germany.
